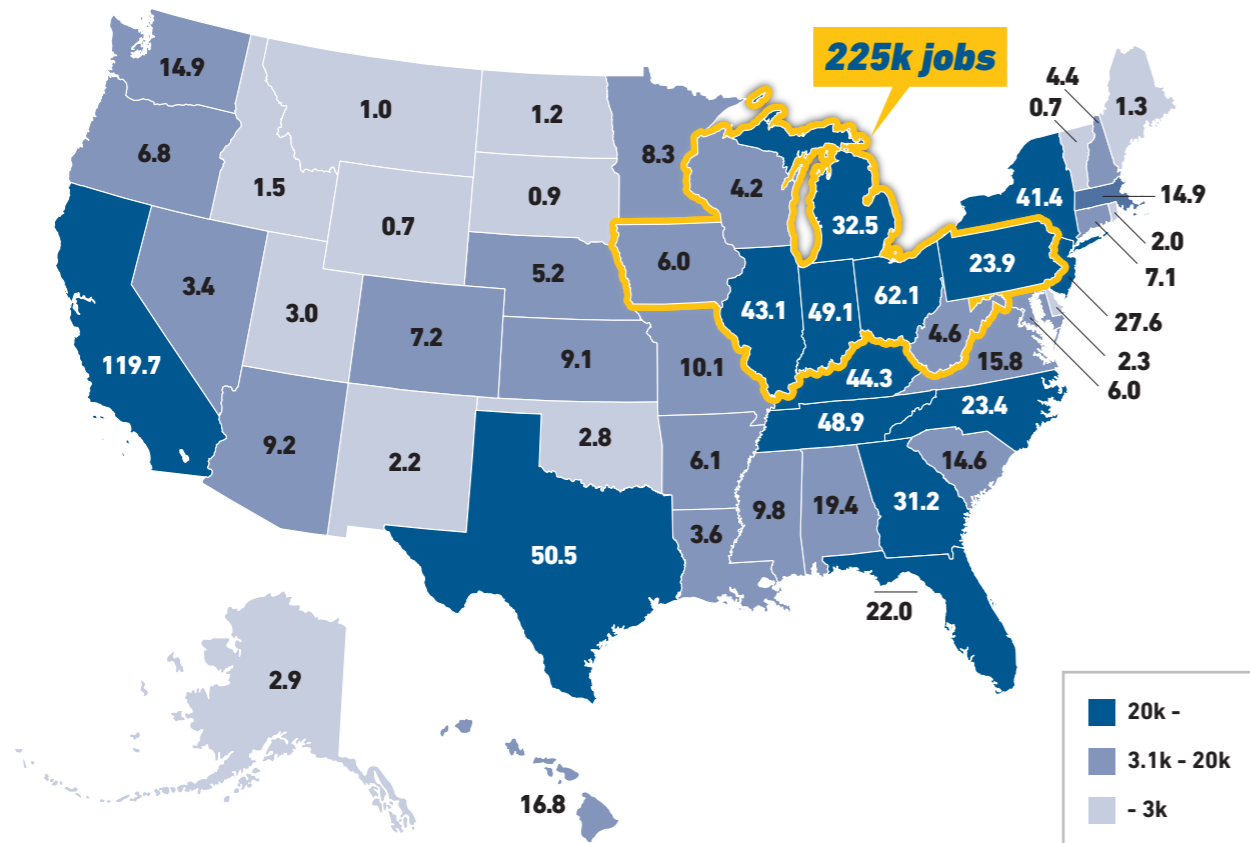


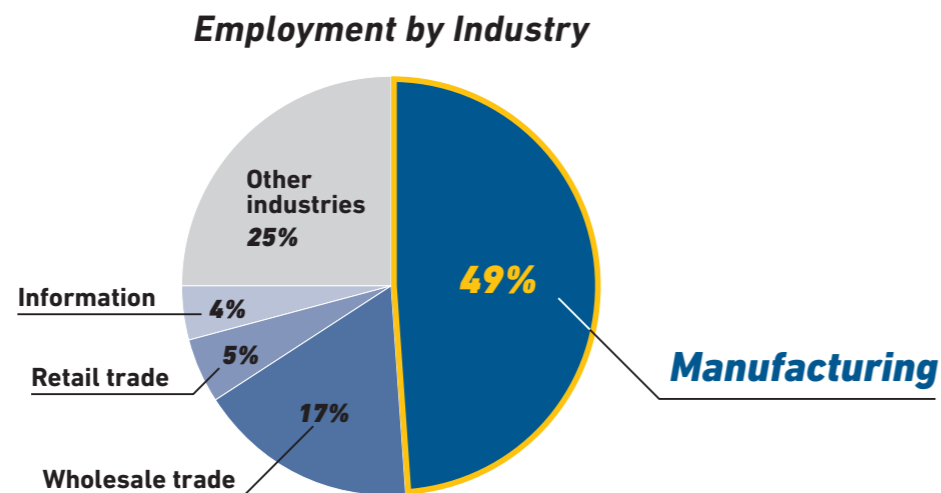
# Japanese firms have created 860k+ American jobs through direct investment

Jobs Created (thousands)



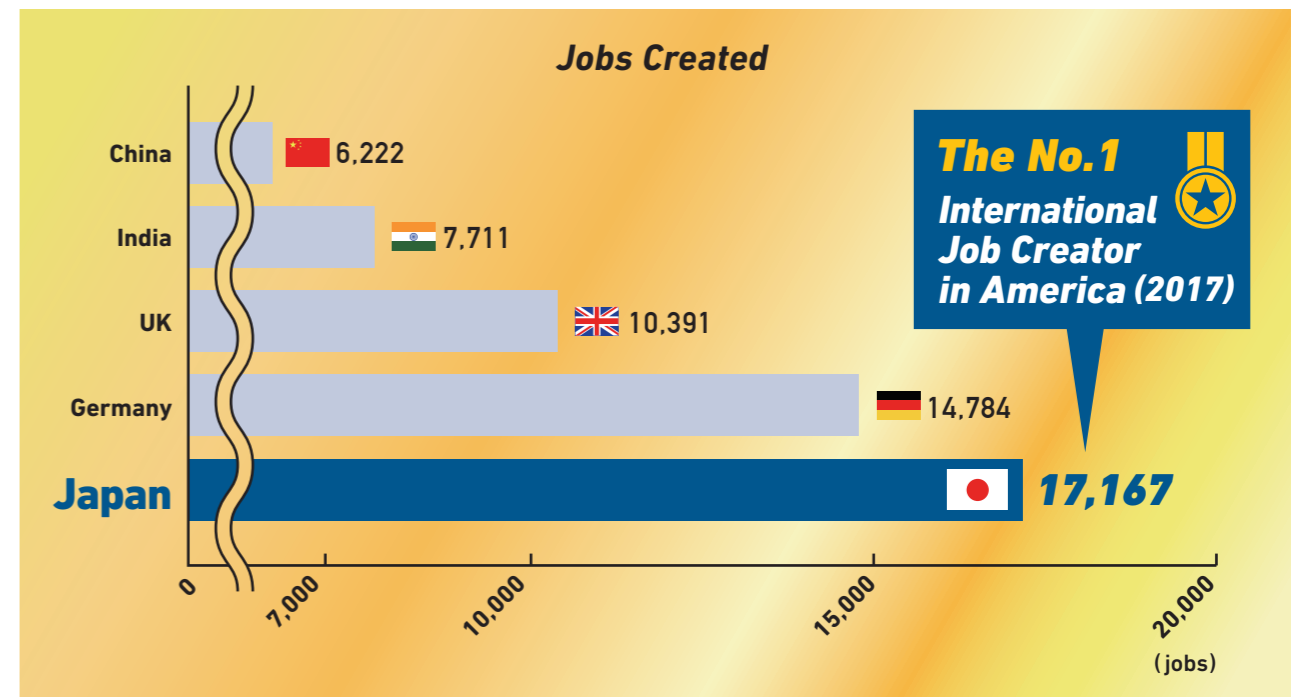

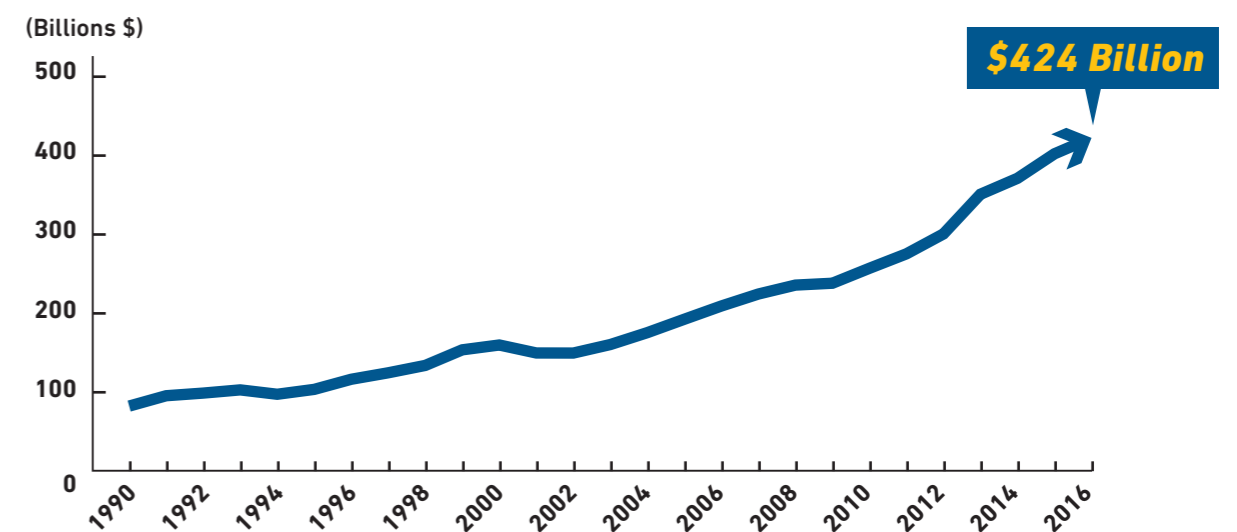

# FDI from Japan has steadily grown for over decades

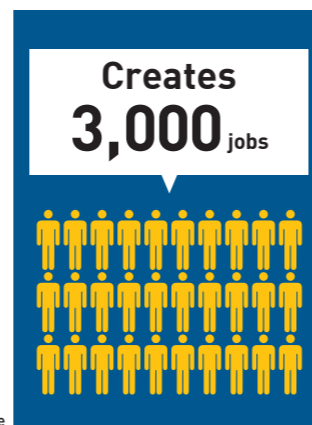

## Highlights of major new Japanese investments announced in 2017



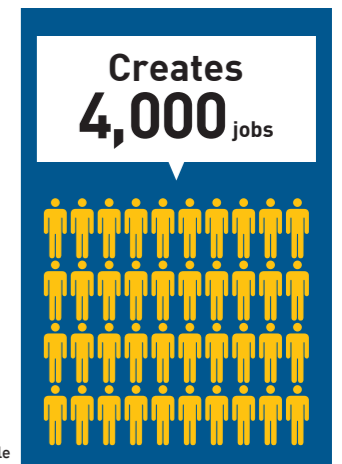
Opened the second-largest air-conditioner factory in the US, enabling American householders to achieve 30% energy savings (May 24).



Expand multiple production lines to produce advanced safety, connectivity and electrification products for hybrid and electric vehicles (Oct. 6).



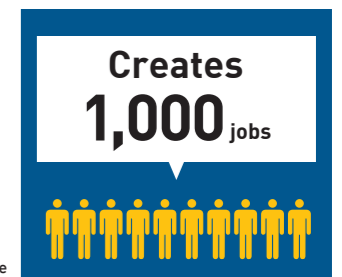
Establish a joint venture that produces vehicles in the U.S. (Aug. 4).



## TOYOTA \$10 billion investment in the U.S. operations over the next five years.



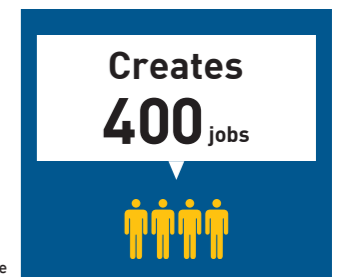
\$1 billion invested in new North American headquarters in Texas (Jul. 6).

\$600 million invested to increase production capacity at Indiana plant (Jan. 24).

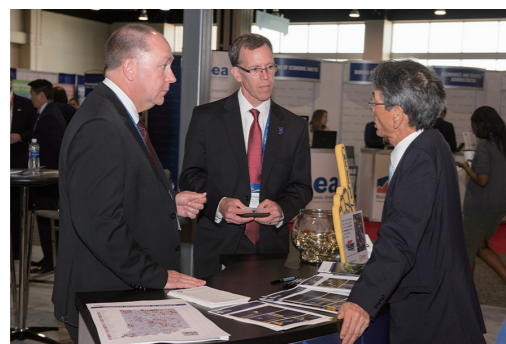


\$373 million invested in 5 plants (West Virginia, Tennessee, Kentucky, Missouri, Alabama) to further expand US production (Sep. 26).

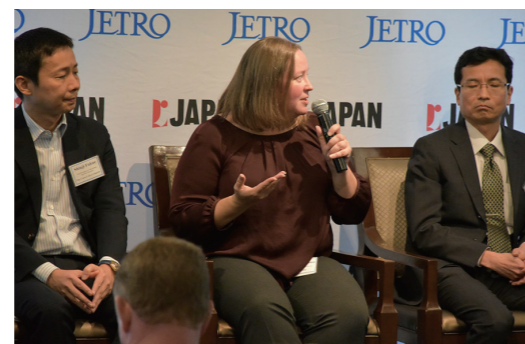

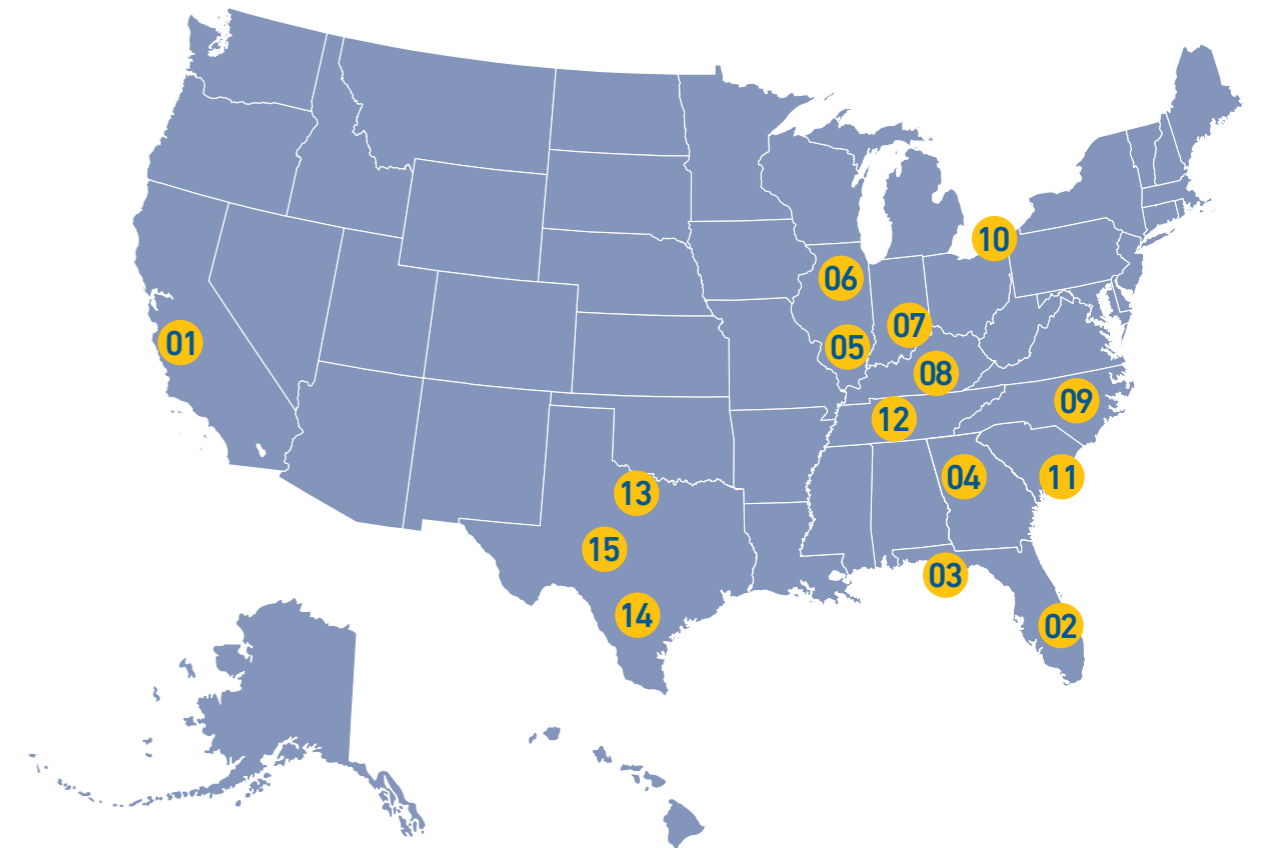
